Year 2 Summer 1

<u>Computing</u>

In Computing this half term we will become programmers of robots and begin to understand how we give clear instructions to ensure the robot completes the tasks required.

English, spelling and phonics

We be focussing on capital letters and full stops in our writing and using our phonics to spell words. We will focus on creating interesting and well written sentences and have a key focus on aspects of grammar. We will continue to learn the year 2 spelling rules and put these into practise in our spelling tests. We will continue to use a range of punctuation, contracted word forms, adjectives and adverbs. The children have been working very hard on their handwriting so we hope they keep up the hard work!

Art and Music
