PSHE—This half terms focus in PSHE is Aspirational Owl! Our year 6 topic is to look at different careers and the skills needed for certain jobs.

Maths This term we are going to focus on measurement, shape, algebra and data Handling, as well as developing our arithmetic skills.

It is very important that the children know all of their times tables, prime, squared and cubed numbers so please practise these at home.

Music

In music we are using the scheme 'Charanga' and continuing to study the song called a 'You've got a friend'.
