Maths

This term we will be working on place value and shape. During these sessions your child will build on the knowledge they have gained in year I and begin to extend this, They will also be looking at a range of different strategies to help them find the correct answers. The children will also have the opportunity to continues to work on their times tables and general mental maths.

Science

We will be focussing on materials and looking at the different properties they have. We will develop our working scientifically skills and write predictions and conclusions.

RE - Why is light an important symbol for Christians, Jews and Hindus?

Children will be able to retell at least one narrative where light is an important symbol. They will be able to recognise that the narratives used by Christians, Hindus and Jews reflect their key beliefs and give an example of how Christmas, Hindu and Jews and beliefs (and the symbolism of light) to guide their daily lives.

PE and Swimming

This term we are learning Tag Rugby and Football skills. This will develop their skills, rules of the game and teamwork.

Children will need full PE and swimming kits to participate - details of these expectations can be found on the year group PowerPoints.

English, spelling and phonics

Our first unit is titled—Silly Billy. We will be talking about some worries children may have and what we can do to make them feel better. We will then be writing letters to ourselves to remind ourselves on how we can get help.
