Home School Agreement

Parents / Carers

I / We will:

- · See that my child goes to school regularly, on time and properly dressed in school uniform and equipped ready for learning.
- · Provide an explanation if my/our child is absent in accordance with the school's attendance policy.
- · Make every effort to avoid taking unauthorised leave of absence during term time in accordance with the school's Attendance Policy.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour and keep the school up to
 date with an emergency contact number.
- Provide a quiet place at home and support my/our child with homework and it being returned on time and other opportunities for home learning.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines.
- Attend parent's evenings and discussions on my/our child's progress, aiming to be positive and productive, working together to
 move on my/our child's learning.
- · Get to know about my/our child's life in school.
- · Encourage my/our child to seek peaceful solutions to problems.
- Check for school communication on a regular basis for information e.g. through reading records, emails, communications books, letters and the website.
- · Help my/our child to understand and follow the school rules and take care of school property
- · Behave in a way that sets a good example when on the school premises.
- · To encourage my/our child to respect the views of others and understand that everyone is of equal importance.
- Be respectful towards members of the school and local community e.g speaking calmly to us, parking responsibly and
 respecting our neighbours property.
- Speak to school staff about concerns, not post adverse comments about children, staff or the school on social networking sites including Facebook.

- · Take messages / homework home and let my parents or carers have them.

- . Keep the school free from litter and graffiti and take care of school property.
- Look after my personal belongings.
- · Follow the school's code of conduct.
- Always behave sensibly in my class and around the school.
- Not use social networking sites, including Facebook, to be unkind about other children, staff or the school.

School

The School will:

- · Strive to promote each child's health, safety and happiness.
- Encourage each child to do their best at all times.
- . Encourage children to take care of the school, the grounds, their belongings and others around them.
- Follow the school's code of conduct.
- Set regular homework for the children that is challenging and meets the child's individual needs to help support progress.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum including extra-curricular opportunities and strive to meet the individual needs
 of each child.
- Ensure that every child is taught at an appropriate and challenging level whilst maintaining an attractive environment with good materials and equipment.
- . Let parents know about any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality.
- · Set high standards of behaviour by promoting the school rules and values by using fair rewards and sanctions.
- · Keep parents informed about general school matters and their child's progress and curriculum in particular.
- Arrange parents evenings during which progress can be discussed and any matters arising.
- · Be open, welcoming and responsive at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in school life.
- Ensure that bullying, racism, sexism and other discriminating behaviour is not tolerated and celebrate the diverse background
 that we all come from.
- Strive to ensure that all children can learn in an atmosphere that is calm and purposeful.
