Maths - Place Value

In this unit we will be focussing on number. We will counting to and across from 100. We will also be counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

The children will also be identifying one more and one less than a given number and reading and writing numbers from I - 20 in numerals and words.



English

We will be completing lots of work on these a variety of stories linked to our topics. We will be learning about the story structure and designing our own characters, before writing our own stories.

We will be making up our own actions to help us to remember the story and be performing for each other.

The children will be encouraged to remember to use capital letters and full stops and to start sentences in different ways.



Science - Animals Including Humans - About Me

In this unit, children will begin their journey of learning about themselves and their bodies. The unit begins with a focus on our senses and the basic parts of the human body. As we journey through the unit, learners will discover the changes our body makes as we grow and also how humans can mimic nature.

PE - Rugby and Football
